NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL Weston Super Half Marathon 2020 ROAD TRAFFIC (SPECIAL EVENTS) ACT 1994 ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16A 17th October 2021

(Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles, Temporary Prohibition of Use by Pedestrians, Cyclists and Equestrians, Temporary One Way, Temporary 30MPH Speed Limit and Temporary Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2021

VARIOUS ROADS, FOOTPATHS AND BRIDLEWAYS IN THE DISTRICT OF NORTH SOMERSET

Whereas the North Somerset Council, as the highway authority for the district has today made an order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as inserted by Section 1 of the Road Traffic (Special Events) Regulation Act 1994 to facilitate the holding of the Weston Super Half Marathon 2021 which will restrict and prohibit the use of certain roads and footpaths shown in the schedules to this Order.

To temporarily prohibit the use by Vehicles specified in Schedule 1 to this Order (with the exception along the Seafront on Knightstone Road and Beach Road for access to Sovereign Centre Multi-storey Car Park and Melrose Car Park). To temporarily prohibit the use by pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians in the various footpaths and bridleways as specified in the Schedule Two of this Order. To implement temporarily One Way traffic restriction in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule Three to this Order. To temporarily suspend the existing speed limit in favour of restricting temporarily any vehicle to 30MPH in the lengths of road specified in Schedule Four to this Order. To temporarily restrict any vehicle from waiting and loading in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 5 of this Order.

Exemptions for association with the event and authorised to do so under the direction of the event organiser and (a) a vehicle used by the fire brigade, police authority, or local authority for their respective purposes (b) an ambulance (c) a vehicle used by an Undertaker as defined in Part III of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (d) a vehicle authorised in particular circumstances or for particular purposes by a police constable, a civil enforcement officer, a police community support officer, an official steward or marshal under the direction of the event organisers or (e) a vehicle which displays in a conspicuous position a written authorisation given by North Somerset Council or event organisers.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger and a requirement for safety to the public and participants due to the Weston-Super- Half 2021 Marathon (referred to as the 'Event'). This order will come into effect at 07:00hrs on 17th October 2021 and will continue in force until 14:00hrs and shall have effect only at such times as indicated by appropriate traffic signs and cones displayed for the Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles, Temporary Prohibition of use by Pedestrians, Cyclists and Equestrians, Temporary One Way, Temporary 30MPH Speed Limit, Temporary Revocation of Driving and Temporary Waiting and Loading restriction. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force

SCHEDULE ONE

Knightstone Road from Birnbeck Road to Royal Parade

Manilla Crescent - from junction with Manilla Place to junction with Knightstone Road

Richmond Street - from its junction with Gloucester Street to its junction with Marine Parade

Uphill Road South - from its junction with Uphill Way to its junction with Bridgwater Road (A370)

Kewstoke Road - from Upper Kewstoke Road to its junction with Beach Road, Kewstoke

Regent Street - from its junction with Marine Parade to its junction with York Street

Accommodation Road - from its junction with A370 Bridgwater Road to Wayacre Drove

Beach Road - from its junction with Carlton Street to its junction with Quantock Road

Bridgwater Road A370 layby/service road between property Bridgeside and southerly junction with Bridgwater Road

The following roads for their entire length:

Links Road, Uphill Way, Royal Parade, Birnbeck Road, Birkett Road, Upper Kewstoke Road (part unadopted)

Marine Parade (unadopted), Wayacre Drove (unadopted), Seafront Promenade - from the junction with Regent Street/Grand Pier to Manilla Crescent (unadopted)

SCHEDULE TWO

All listed for the entire length;

AX6/1, AX6/4, AX/6/5, AX31/53 Bridleways

AX31/2a, AX31/3, AX31/4

CYCLE WAY 33 (not Public Right Of Way) Weston to Brean Cycle Way - from Uphill Marine Centre in a southerly direction to AX6/5 Bridleway

SCHEDULE THREE

Bridgwater Road (A370) - at its junction with Accommodation Road in a northerly direction to its junction with Uphill Road South and A370 layby/service road between property Bridgeside and Nore Leigh no left turn on to Bridgwater Road

Park Place - from its junction of Park Place to Knightstone Road

Victoria Square - no right turn from Victoria Square on to Royal Parade

Princess Royal Square - no right turn on to Royal Parade

Bleadon Hill - no left turn on to Bridgewater Road

Knightstone Road - no right turn on to Royal Parade

Fakeham Road - no left turn on to Bridgwater Road

SCHEDULE FOUR

Bridgwater Road (A370) - at its junction with Accommodation Road the speed restriction commences for 1350 metres in a northerly direction and continues to its junction with Uphill Road South in assocation with a lane closure.

SCHEDULE FIVE

As and when traffic cones/signs dictate and are in force.

Uphill Road South - between its junction with Uphill Way and Grange Road

Grange Road - on the south side between its junction with Uphill Road South and the Hospital entrance

Grange Road - on the north side for the first set of parking spaces with the same footprint as above

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES

During the period of this order appropriate signage will be displayed to facilitate the diversion route whilst closures are in place required for the event.
