

Locking Parish Council – CIL Report

2021/22 CIL

The Community Infrastructure Levy, CIL, is a charge which can be levied by Local Authorities on new developments in their area. Council collects this levy and where developments are within the Parish Council area, 15% of that levy is passed onto the Parish Council.

CIL monies can be used to support the development of the local area to fund:

- (a) the provision, improvement, replacement, operation or maintenance of infrastructure, or
- (b) anything else that is concerned with addressing the demands that development places on the area.

Infrastructure includes physical, social and green infrastructure, e.g., Highways, cycle ways, education facilities, sports and community halls, park and play area.

CIL monies cannot be used for everyday Parish Council expenditure or for spending on items or services which fall outside the Parish Council's remit.

Below are the CIL reports which gives details of the CIL monies received and spent by Locking Parish Council.
