E15) To Elect a Vice Chairman.

RESOLVED: That Cllr Peter Lacey be elected.

MATTERS FOR DECISION

E19) FC Locking To receive a report and decide on information provided. A report was received from a representative of FC Locking. Deadlines were discussed and agreed for required information to be presented to LPC in an agreed time scale leading up to the next Full Council Meeting to be held on the 7th September 2017. It was agreed that LPC would provide 4 signs for FC Locking to be erected in the Playing Field area to deter Dog Fouling. A grant application form to be sent to FC Locking for an extra Dog Bin for the Playing Field.

E23) Overseers: To receive reports for the following:

•Playing Field/The Triangle – Cllr J Keate reported that rubbish has been dumped in the Triangle. Clerk to contact Scouts as it may be their cleanup operation.

•PROWS – No report received. Cllr P Lacey said he will be in a position to report at next meeting.

•Allotments – Cllr C Blinco commented that a review should take place with two Cllrs & the Clerk.

•Open Spaces – Cllr C Blinco raised concerns regarding the tree growing in the RANSOM STRIP. Cllr P Lacey suggested that it should be a proposal for a project for next year to clear up as no one is taking responsibility for this area of land.

E24) Allotments Paths: Update. Three quotes have been requested. One contractor has pulled out and we are waiting receive the other two quotes.

E25) **Overgrown Vegetation:** Update. Clerk to contact NSC regarding overgrown vegetation at the Garage close to the junction with the A371.

E26) **Triangle (Scouts):** Update. A report was received from the Scout Leader stating what progress has been made since they took over the Triangle field. Clerk to write to Scout Leader congratulating him and his Scouts & Cubs for what they have achieved in their first six months.

E27) Dog Bin Coordinator: To agree overtime to be paid for 2 weeks holiday cover for Parish Orderly. Proposed and seconded that overtime should be paid. CARRIED.
